01 GENERAL INFORMATION

The Meeting Maia Cidade do Desporto 2025 is an outdoor track and field athletics tournament, integrated into the FPA – Portuguese Athletics Federation – meeting circuit and the **World Athletics Continental Tour – BRONZE Category – C.**

The meeting will take place in the city of Maia, on **19 July 2025**, at the athletics track of **Prof. Dr. Vieira de Carvalho Stadium**, and is organised by **Maia Atlético Clube**, in collaboration with **Maia City Council** and the **Porto Athletics Association (AAP)**.

03 PARTICIPANTS

Participation is open to athletes registered with the Portuguese Athletics Federation (FPA) for the 2024/2025 season. Foreign athletes may participate with a valid athletics license and prior authorisation from their respective National Federation to compete in Portugal.

04 REGISTRATIONS

Pre-registrations must be requested by email - mmcdesporto@gmail.com and through a link, <https://meetingmaiacidadedodesporto.pt/participation-request/>, to be made available shortly **from 11 June to 14 July 2025**, until 11:00pm. Through mmcdesporto@gmail.com provide the following information: first and last name, date of birth, gender, club, nationality, event in which you are participating, RP (Personal Record) and SB (Best mark of the season), telephone contact and email. It is important to bear in mind that the fact that your pre-registration is accepted does not guarantee entry.

05 ADMITTED ATHLETES

5.1 Admission Criteria

- Athletes invited by the organisation
- Athletes who completed pre-registration within the official deadline

Inclusion in the pre-registration list does **not guarantee participation**, as the organisation reserves the right to select athletes. Each event has a maximum quota, as detailed below:

5.2. Conditions for Multiple Heat

- 200m: Two heats will only be held if at least **12 athletes** are registered and the performance level justifies it. Otherwise, only one heat will take place.
- 100m (Men): Up to three heats may occur if **24 or more high-quality entries** are received. Otherwise, only one or two heats will be organised, based on 5.1.

06 IMPLEMENT HOMOLOGATION

Personal implements are allowed, provided they are homologated. Implements must be handed in at the **Call Room** for verification **120 minutes before** the scheduled start of the event. Approved implements will be placed in the competition area and made available to all athletes.

07 CONFIRMATION & BIB NUMBER PICK-UP

All admitted athletes must confirm their participation and collect their bib numbers at the competition office no later than 180 minutes before the start of their event.

08 FINAL COMPETITION TIMETABLE

The final competition schedule and Start List will be published on 4 July 2025 by the organisation.

10 PRIZES

The MMCD25 – part of the **WA Continental Tour BRONZE** – will award a total of **€30,150**, distributed to the **top 5 athletes** in each event as follows:

1st place	€600
2nd place	€450
3rd place	€300
4th place	€200
5th place	€125

In events with multiple heats where no final is held, classification prizes, as well as points awarded by World Athletics, will be assigned based on the overall results across all heats, ranked in general order.

Prizes and any other reimbursable expenses will be paid **within 90 days**, upon submission of an invoice or official receipt **(single act in Portuguese tax system)** within two weeks following the event.

This procedure is mandatory for **all Portuguese and foreign athletes**.

A formal **podium ceremony** will be held for the 1st place in each event, as soon as conditions allow.

11 ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

In accordance with World Athletics regulations, anti-doping control tests will be conducted on a random and/or targeted selection basis. The analysis must be carried out at the WADA-accredited laboratory assigned for the event, in compliance with WADA standards and World Athletics Guidelines, with a minimum of five samples to be tested.

12 APPLICABLE RULES

Any omitted cases in this regulation will follow the rules set by the **FPA (Portuguese Athletics Federation) and World Athletics.**
